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**Eligibility**

**Active Membership:** Active membership shall be open to all persons within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts who own or lease 1,000 sq.ft. of greenhouse space (example: 20 x 50 sq.ft. greenhouse), or a minimum of 1/2 acre of land outdoors, and devoted to the commercial production and marketing of floricultural products including the following: annuals, perennials, foliage plant products, cut flowers (greenhouse or field grown), potted or cut bulb products, garden mums, herbs and vegetable transplants (edible or ornamental). Examples of typical business categories: wholesale, retail grower, garden centers, farmers and farm stand operators or landscaping businesses (growing perennials or annuals for internal use or commercial sale).

**Allied Trade Membership:** Formerly Associate membership, shall be open only to persons or businesses interested in the flower/plant industry who have products or services related to the production, marketing and support of the floriculture industry in Massachusetts. This membership is for individuals or businesses that are within or outside of Massachusetts.

**Supporter:** This category is for individuals or educational institutions who are interested in the activities and information offered by the Association. Examples include: educators, schools, students, former non active members who are out of the floriculture business. This category will be eligible to receive the Association newsletter via email and attend at a special rate any educational program.
